Entry requirements

For admission to the Master of Arts (TESOL) applicants must have successfully completed an undergraduate degree or postgraduate qualification in any discipline. International students, or those whose language of instruction for their undergraduate degree was in a language other than English, need an IELTS score of 7.0 overall, with a minimum of 6.0 in each subtest.

For admission to the Graduate Diploma and Graduate Certificate courses applicants must have successfully completed an undergraduate or postgraduate degree in any discipline.

Recognition of prior learning

Special equivalence may be granted to candidates on the basis of evidence submitted at the time of application, for academic, professional and/or any other qualifications held.

Pathways

Students enrolled in the Master of Arts (TESOL) have the option of exiting with a Graduate Diploma in TESOL after completing four specified core units or a Graduate Certificate in TESOL after completing three specified core units.
