

Getting to and from UWS Parramatta campus



The Parramatta campus consists of two sites: Parramatta North and Parramatta South. The Parramatta South campus is the main teaching campus and is approximately 5 minutes walk from the Victoria Road bus stop. Students are advised to exercise caution when crossing Victoria Road (corner of Rippon and Anderson Avenues). Visit www.uws.edu.au/campus.

Getting from Parramatta South to Parramatta North campus

The walk from Parramatta South to Parramatta North is approximately 10-12 minutes. Walk north along The Avenue on Parramatta South to the unmade path and onto the pedestrian bridge over James Ruse Drive. Turn left and left again and cross at the marked pedestrian crossing travelling west along Victoria Road. Entry to Parramatta North is part way along the fence. Alternatively, catch the shuttle from the bus stop north of Building EA.



Parramatta Station is located at the Parramatta Transport Interchange and is serviced by the Western, Cumberland and Blue Mountains lines. Alight here for frequent bus services to Parramatta campus.

Rydalmere Station is serviced by the Carlingford Line (mostly hourly services). Change at Clyde when travelling on the Western line to access Rydalmere station. From the station it is approximately 10 minutes walk to campus. It is recommended you catch the train to Parramatta Station where more frequent bus services to campus are available.



Sydney Buses and other bus operators offer wheelchair accessible services at limited times. Look for the accessible symbol on the bus operator's timetable to identify these services. All Metrobus m52 services are low floor and accessible.

Parramatta Station is wheelchair accessible. Specific station details can be found on the CityRail website www.cityrail.com.au or contact Transport Info.



Sydney Buses, Hillsbus, Hopkinsons, Metrobus and **Veolia Services** run frequent bus services to the Parramatta Transport Interchange during peak periods.

To travel to Parramatta campus catch Sydney Buses m52, 520, 521, 523, 524 and 525 services from Stand A2 (3-5 Sections or approximately \$3.40 Adult/\$1.60 Concession). Please note these services are PrePay only.

A campus shuttle service is provided between the south (main teaching campus) and north Parramatta campuses at no charge for students, staff and visitors from 6.30am to 10.30pm in teaching periods. See the Parramatta campus webpage for bus route maps for surrounding regions and more information.



The Parramatta Rivercat operates between Circular Quay and Parramatta. Alight at Rydalmere Wharf to access Parramatta campus. From Rydalmere Wharf either catch Sydney Buses 524 from the corner of John and South Streets or cycle to campus (approximately an 8-10 minute ride)



Parramatta campus is best accessed via the shared pathway which runs along the Parramatta River on the Parramatta South campus side. Showers are available in Building EA, lower ground level, Building ED and Building EF. On the north campus showers are located in LZ.G.64 (men) and LZ.G.34 (women). Thinking about cycling to campus? Entrance to the Parramatta South campus is via Victoria Road. Entrance to the Parramatta North campus is via Pemberton Street.

Please be aware that parking on Parramatta campus is limited and parking permits and fees apply. From 28 February 2011 parking on Parramatta South campus requires a blue, red or disabled permit. Daily blue permits are available from parking meters. See the UWS Parking webpage for more information.
