

## UWS 2000-2005 Community Engagement Analysis Version 4

Over the period 2000 - 2005 some 1172 engagement projects were reported to be underway or completed by Colleges and Divisions. This number does not include memberships of UWS staff in community organisations and professional associations. Of the projects in the (then) four Colleges almost 50% (417 out of 835) were run out of the College of Arts; 337 projects were operated from the Divisions. Total number of distinct projects and activities - 721, number of distinct partners - 865.
