# Getting to and from UWS Bankstown campus

## Planning your Trip

UWS recommends contacting the Transport Info Line to plan your trip and obtain the latest timetable, fare and wheelchair accessible information. Visit [www.mobile.131500.com.au](http://www.mobile.131500.com.au) to plan your trip and easily access 131500 transport information on your mobile phone.



Veolia buses stop directly outside the campus with a minute's walk to the Library and Student Central.



CityRail stations with bus services to the Bankstown campus include:

**East Hills Station** serviced by the Airport and East Hills Line. Approximately a 15 minute bus trip to campus via Veolia bus 922.

**Bankstown Station** serviced by the Bankstown Line. Approximately a 25 minute bus trip to campus via Veolia bus m90 and 922.

**Liverpool Station** serviced by the Cumberland, South, Inner West and Bankstown Lines. Approximately a 30 minute bus trip to campus via Veolia bus m90.

**Burwood and Strathfield Stations** serviced by the Inner West, South, Northern and Western Lines. It is approximately an hour to campus via Veolia bus m90.

**Revesby, Panania and Padstow Stations** serviced by the Veolia S5 bus. It is approximately a 13-15 minute trip to campus.



**Metrobus m90** operates from Burwood, Bankstown and Liverpool stations to campus seven days a week.

**Veolia S5** Panania-Revesby operates a limited service from Milperra to Padstow via Panania and Revesby and provides an easy connection for the Metrobus m91 at Padstow.

**Veolia 922** operates seven days a week between Bankstown Interchange and East Hills train station.



You can cycle to campus along Horsley Road and from Panania train station. Revesby Station provides bicycle lockers and lift access. The University is continuing to improve its cycling facilities.

Bicycle parking is available on campus outside the Library, Building 23 and the UWSCoconnect gym. The University will continue to improve end of trip facilities.



Showers are available in Building 18 (Accessible Toilet), UWS Connect Gym, and Building 20 (Accessible Toilet).



The entrance to the campus is via Bullecourt Avenue. Using the M5, take the Henry Lawson Drive exit. Turn left at Henry Lawson Drive then right onto Bullecourt Avenue.
