STUDENT TRAVEL CONCESSIONS CONDITIONS

To be eligible for student concession travel you must:

- be a full time student, attending day classes
- be aged 16 years or older (excluding school pupils aged 16, 17 or 18 years)
- not be engaged in business or employment
- not receive any remuneration (scholarships and allowances such as Austudy and Youth Allowance are not counted as remuneration)
- not be a full fee paying overseas student

When you use your concession travel privilege, you must:

- Always carry your card and show it when buying your ticket, and when requested by a Transport Officer
- Not give or lend your card to any other person

Full fare must be paid if you are unable to produce your card.

You must not obtain student concession travel if you can no longer comply with the eligibility conditions above.

Providing false information or any breach of the conditions above could render you liable for prosecution.

Your educational establishment will usually be able to authorise your concession travel. If it is unable to do so, it will be able to advise you as to how to obtain your travel concessions.
